



2017 RED BLEND KNIGHTS VALLEY, SONOMA COUNTY

Winemaking

Grapes hand-harvested at night, sorted, destemmed, then undergo a 72-hour cold soak before beginning traditional fermentation with two pumpovers per day for 14 days; aged 18 months in 50% new French oak.

Tasting Notes

This is the perfect counterpoint to pure Cabernet Sauvignon, with blending varieties on full display. Merlot provides a textural, sweet mouthfeel while Cabernet Franc adds aromas of cacao powder and a resonant finish of Ghana chocolate. Petit Verdot plays a supporting role among the blending varieties, lending depth, color, and a structural framework. Drink now through 2030.
