VINTAGE

The 2023 growing season kicked off in Knights Valley with above-average winter rains, which replenished reservoirs and rejuvenated soils. While cooler temperatures meant a slow start, the abundant rainfall fostered lush canopy development in late spring and summer that led to balanced yields at harvest. Picking started slightly later than usual but finished by mid-October, delivering exceptional fruit with deeply intense flavors.

WINEMAKING

Fruit was hand-picked in the early morning hours of September 22, then the grapes were gently pressed and settled for 72 hours to gain clarity before moving to aging vessels. This beautifully balanced Sauvignon Blanc embraces new oak fermentation, with 42% of the blend in French oak enhancing the naturally golden character and complex aromas of Sauvignon Musqué. The remaining 58% is aged in stainless steel, preserving the freshness of the fruit and a thread of minerality. This wine takes months to ferment which slowly draws out the complex aromas, superfine texture, and impressive weight, and ensures that it will continue to evolve beautifully with bottle age for many years to come.

VINEYARD

The 2023 Fairview is sourced from a single block, 6B, of Sauvignon Blanc "Musque" from our Knights Bridge Estate Vineyard. "Musque" is a unique clonal selection that delivers an exotic array of aromas, a superfine texture and impressive weight. We choose to plant Sauvignon Blanc exclusively on clay loam soils since they retain moisture in the soil profile throughout the season allowing the varietal to develop complete flavors for a pure and concise expression.
