He has broadened his global perspective by traveling through France and studying Enology and Terroir at the University of Bordeaux. At home, he completed the Wine Executive MBA at Sonoma State University and participates in Napa Valley Vintners' Leadership Program, reflecting his commitment to both the craft of winemaking and the community.
